

A Simple Organizational Description of the HCMA Prayer Movement

1. HCMA facilitates a 24/7 Prayer Watch over the county. Our goal is to include at least 100 churches and ministries.
2. We offer an every-other-month prayer gathering, with the goal of powerful, united prayer for revival in our county and world-wide evangelization. This meeting will be led by pastors, prayer coordinators and intercessors, and we hope that members of churches around the county will come in big numbers to help us humbly ask God for unity and revival in our county.
3. We host a monthly, Pastor's and Prayer Coordinator's gathering (normally the first Monday of every month, 12:30-1:30 PM). These meetings will give strength to the Prayer Watch and Prayer Gatherings. The meetings will run for one hour, after which prayer over the county may continue for those able to stay.
 - Pastors should come as often as they can, but not feel obligated to always make a showing. Our aim is to make ministry better, not to make pastors busier.
 - Pastors are the shepherds over this prayer movement. Therefore, they should each appoint at least one prayer coordinator, who will be sure to attend these meetings. The prayer coordinators should, under that pastor's supervision, establish the prayer ministry for the church.
4. To build prayer ministries in churches around the county.
 - These local prayer ministries may be as simple as a few people gathering weekly to intercede over the church and county.
 - Ideally, each church will soon form a prayer team that will develop for the church: a prayer watch (as part of the county-wide prayer watch) and regular (monthly or every-other-month) church-wide prayer gatherings.

5. We will add more dimensions to the Henderson County Prayer Movement as it solidifies (prayer walks, prayer summits, prayer conferences, etc.).

We can organize, but only the Lord can bring spiritual awakening. Please pray for God to accept this feeble effort as an altar of worship, upon which he sends His heavenly fires of renewal.
